Recommended Immunizations:

Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap) – An adult dose of dTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) is recommended, followed by a Tetanus-diphtheria (Td) every 10 years

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) – two doses are required if born in 1970 or later **OR** a blood test showing immunity to Measles, Mumps and Rubella

Chicken Pox (Varicella) – Staff known to have had the chicken pox disease are considered immune. Staff who are unsure may have a blood test done to determine immunity. Chicken Pox can cause severe illness and complications in adults. It is **strongly** encouraged that staff who are not immune should have 2 doses of varicella vaccine at least 28 days apart.

Other considerations for vaccinations include:

Annual Influenza - Infants and young children are considered to be at high risk for complications of Influenza which may lead to hospitalization. An annual influenza is strongly encouraged for anyone who works with this high risk group.

Hepatitis B – is a series of 2 or 3 doses (depending on age at time of vaccination) and strongly recommended for anyone who may be exposed to blood or who may be at increased risk of sharps injury, bites or penetrating injuries.

Staff should submit their immunization information 24/7 online using the secure, online immunization portal ICON (Immunization Connect) at www.huronhealthunit.ca/ICON. If your immunizations are not up to date according to Health Unit records, the missing immunizations will be listed at the bottom of this record.
